Programme	Third programme of the Union's action in the field of health (2014-2020)
Funding agency	European Commission - Directorate-General Health and Consumers (DG SANCO) Implementation via the Consumers, Health and Food Executive Agency (Chafea)
Objective	Complementary to the R&D-oriented Horizon 2020 calls, the Health Programme aims to <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Promote good practices for cost-effective disease prevention • Develop and implement coherent approaches for better preparedness and coordination in health emergencies • Contribute to innovative, efficient and sustainable health systems • Increase access to cross-border medical expertise
Themes	Pre-defined thematic priorities in the area of health
Timing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Call for proposals: One call for proposals a year. • Proposal submission: One submission deadline a year • Project start: Maximum 9 months after proposal submission
Consortium	Minimum 3 partners from 3 different countries, typically 7-13 partners
Duration	Usually 3 years
Funding rates	60% funding, in exceptional cases 80%
Total Funding	0.5 - 1.5 million euro per project
Success criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Policy relevance (in line with EU health policies, added value at EU level) • Technical quality (Scientific soundness, innovative nature, appropriate evaluation foreseen, etc.) • Management quality (Capacity of partners & sound project organisation) • Overall and detailed budget (appropriate, balanced and consistent)
Success rate	Approximately 30% on average during the 2nd EU Health Programme 2008-2013. Success rate is not known for 3rd Health Programme yet.
